Abstract

I combine university research and teaching activities in the area of e-learning, audiovisual media, education and communication technologies, instructional design.

My current research activity concerns theoretical aspects on the principles of visual communication, in relation to the relationship between multimedia learning and cognitive processes. The application field is that of the development of multimedia artifacts aimed at improving learning in the e-learning environment and in mediated teaching (instructional design). In this perspective since 2000 I have supervised the *Audiovisual and multimedia laboratory* of the University of Ferrara, created with the aim of supporting the University's mediatised teaching activities (distance learning, mixed, didactics in the presence implemented by the use of technologies).

From 1998 at the Department of Humanities of Ferrara's University I taught in undergraduate and graduate degrees (about 80 courses). My current interest in teaching regards the area of *Digital and media education*, with particular attention to the visual communication.

Research and teaching have been accompanied by audiovisuals and multimedia communication activity, for the University of Ferrara and for public and private organizations. I founded the cultural association Open Media Educational that works in the field of media education and digital citizenship.
